Houghton divides his time between studio-based work and documentary residencies.

Jeremy has completed artist residencies for the 2017 Wimbledon Tennis Championships, Land Rover Ben Ainslie Racing at the America's Cup in 2016, at Goodwood for the Earl of March in 2015 and at Windsor Castle for Her Majesty The Queen in 2014.
